In response to the escalating concerns around the COVID-19 situation, the organizers of DevOpsDays Houston have decided that it would be ill-advised to continue with the April event as planned. We have reached an agreement to reschedule the event to August 18-19, 2020, while preserving the existing program and sponsors.

[For attendees] Your already purchased ticket is valid for the new dates, and we hope you will be able to join us then.

[For sponsors] Sponsorship fees are non-refundable. Please remember that this is a nonprofit community-run event not backed by any company or organization. We use all the collected funds to put on the event, and we are committed to paying all those monies to our venue, food, AV, etc. suppliers. You can request to be put on a refund list and if we sell out and can resell your slot we will refund you. In the case of a major event (like the conference being forced to cancel due to coronavirus) we will do our best to recoup costs from our suppliers and may be able to offer full or partial refunds, but that is us doing our best effort to do the right thing; we are unable to commit to it in any way.

Of course, we will continue to monitor the situation going forward and update this statement if needed. Ultimately, the health and well-being of all involved is our top priority.
